

MICROSOFT 365 vs EXCLAIMER



There are many pain points that IT administrators deal with when it comes to managing signatures.

- Microsoft 365 signature updates are time difficult to configure.
- HTML email signature designs have to be copied and pasted into the Microsoft 365 disclaimer editor.
- Blank spaces can appear in contact details depending on the Active Directory data used.
- No way to place email signatures under replies or create separate reply signatures.
- Getting users to use uniform email signature templates - no consistency.
- Have to create lots of Transport Rules for different departmental signatures.
- HTML email signatures on mobile devices and Macs aren't possible.
- Email signature designs can't be tested before they are deployed to users.
- Images can't be embedded directly into signatures - have to be hosted elsewhere.
